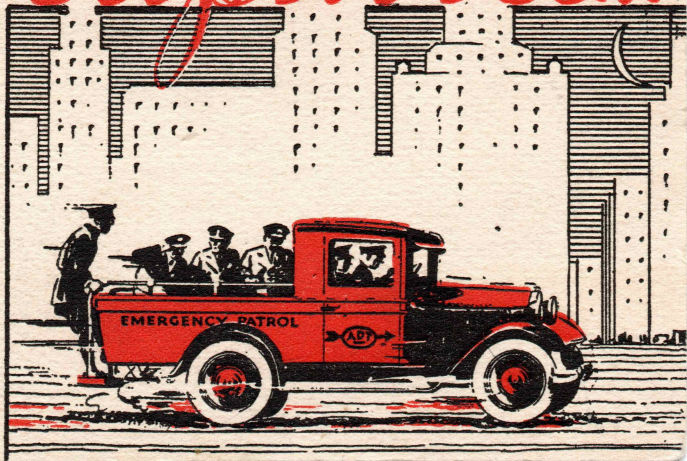

**This Six Year Record** of A.D.T. performance reveals the trend of criminal attacks on business properties and shows the exceptional value of A.D.T. Central Station Burglar Alarm Service in providing security and peace of mind.

**During 1933** in addition to the foregoing there were thirty-one captures resulting from emergency alarms—making a total of **287** captures for the year.

**134** alarms were caused by firemen forcing entry in the performance of duty.

**251** unlocked doors were discovered.

In proportion to the number of subscribers protected, the frequency of attacks by burglars has increased more than one hundred per cent during the past six years. The record shows also that A.D.T. has met the challenge with increased activity and efficiency . . . and with disastrous results to the burglars.
