In addition to the 272 captures shown in the table on the opposite page, there were 22 captures resulting from Holdup Alarms; a total of 294 captures during 1934.

Alarms resulting from other than unlawful attacks included:

137 alarms caused by firemen forcing entry in the performance of duty.

334 alarms caused by doors that had been left unlocked.

The frequency of attacks by burglars has increased more than one hundred per cent during the past five years. The records show that A. D. T. efficiency has more than kept pace with the challenge of the burglar.
