## The Odds Are Against Him

MOST SIGNIFICANT in the table on the opposite page are the figures in the second column. These show that during the past four years there has been a constant *decrease* in the number of attacks on A.D.T. protected premises. But, during this time, there has also been a constant *increase* in the number of properties using A.D.T. protection. Which means that more and more, burglars are avoiding premises protected by A.D.T.

And why this shyness on the part of the criminal element? Because the burglar realizes, as the figures show, that in attacking A.D.T. protection, the odds are heavily against him.
