PATROL EFFICIENCY . . . 99⁹⁴/₁₀₀%

163,953 times during the past year, A.D.T. Central Stations investigated watchmen's failures to transmit their signals at the time prescribed. But this figure represents only 6/100ths of 1% of the total number of signals that were supervised, or a patrol efficiency for A.D.T. supervised watchmen of **99⁹⁴/₁₀₀%**. Consider also the fire record. During 1936, alarms turned in from A.D.T. Manual Fire Alarm Boxes numbered **1,435**.

FIRE LOSS IMMUNITY . . . 99⁹⁷/₁₀₀%

Fire losses, in relation to insurable values protected, amounted to **2/100ths of 1%**.
