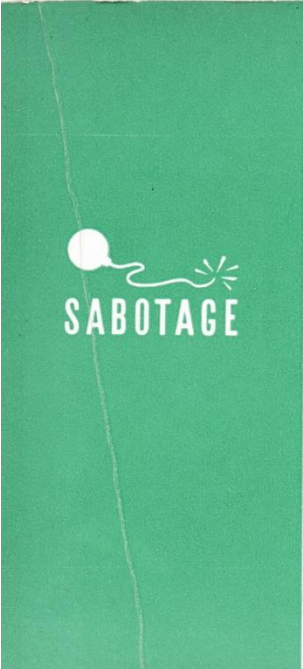

### 338 CAPTURES DURING 1942

During 1942, alarms from A.D.T. Burglary and Holdup Protection Systems (including Invisible Ray Systems for sabotage protection) resulted in a total of 338 captures, as follows:

Captures resulting from burglar alarms . . . **288**

Captures resulting from holdup and other emergency alarms . . . . . **50**

In addition, 561 alarms resulted from other causes, as follows:

Firemen forcing entrances in performance of duty . . . . . **111**

Policemen or others trying doors that had been left unlocked . . . . . **450**

The effectiveness of the services in preventing losses is shown on the opposite page.

## 99.997% IMMUNITY FROM BURGLARY LOSS

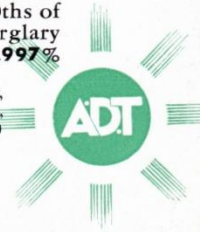
While the record of captures made is impressive evidence of the efficiency of A.D.T. and the police, captures are only incidental to loss prevention. The following figures are convincing evidence of the effectiveness of A.D.T. Protection in accomplishing its primary purpose:
